REASON WHY

❖ **Build a sense of community (Paired School)**

- More diversity in the demographics of student backgrounds, combination of populations may lead to a more unified community (no more "those kids"), more parental support and involvement

❖ **Fluent Middle school Transition**

❖ **Lack of space for K-1 at Central (New K-3 Class Size Law)**

❖ **Decrease transfers back and forth**

❖ **School Focus or Specialty**

- Upper grades teachers would have a team to plan where right now we are isolated in our subject areas.
