Clothing items may not contain ads or endorsements for alcohol, tobacco, or messages inconsistent with the philosophy of the Church/school. The school reserves the right to determine suitability of dress and to require corrective action when deemed necessary. If you do not choose to participate in the dress down days, then **you must wear the complete school uniform properly**. Parts of the school uniform may not be mixed with dress down attire.

**Fri. Jan. 11 General Dress Guidelines for ALL CLASSES:**

### Coming Home Theme

Dear students,

The Administration reserves the right to determine suitability of dress/grooming for all school functions and to require corrective action when deemed necessary.

1. **If you choose to wear any part of the school uniform, you must be in complete uniform and it must be worn properly.** You cannot wear any part of the school uniform as dress-down attire.
2. You may not wear any uniforms/apparel of any other high school.
3. All clothing must cover the same amount of your body as our school uniform.
4. **No shorts of any kind.** Jeans, khakis and skirts must be worn as part of costume. Only girls can wear skirts and they must be knee length. If a girl wears tights, a knee length skirt must be worn over them.
5. No baggy, oversize clothing, torn ragged clothing or tight clothing
6. Shoes or sandals must be worn. **No high heel shoes or flip flops.**
7. No face paint of any kind or any markings on face. (Including eye black under eyes.)
8. **No fake weapons as props.** Masks and “props” (safe ones) at the pep rally only. Masks must be removed upon request.
9. No scrubs or sleep pants. No athletic football pants, baseball pants, etc.)
10. Boys may not wear make-up, skirts or nail polish.
11. You may not take time out of class or in class to “dress” for the day or the pep rally. Come to school in your dress for the day.
12. No clothing or costume may stereotype or show any disrespect to any culture, race, religion; nor may the costume be offensive to any culture, race, religion. Example: no confederate flags.
13. Clothing items may not contain ads or endorsements for alcohol, tobacco, or messages inconsistent with the philosophy of the Church/school.
14. The Admin Team will have the final say on all dress to determine if it is appropriate.

### Theme for the Day:

**Seniors and Freshmen: Athletes (Favorite team or sport, Represent a sport)**

**Sophomores and Juniors: Mathletes (Scholar, Professor, Nerd, Geek,)**

**All costumes for Dance and Spirit Dress Day must adhere to the general guidelines above.**

## **Glow Party:**

This will be held at the CYO on Friday, Jan. 1, from 9:00 p.m. to 11 p.m. You must arrive at the party no later than 15 minutes after the varsity boy's game ends and you may not leave until 11:00 p.m. The Dress Code for the party is **theme, "Glow"**. The school reserves the right to determine suitability of dress and to require corrective action when deemed necessary. **Only McGill-Toolen students can attend** and must adhere to McGill-Toolen dress codes, grooming regulations, and behavior expected of McGill-Toolen students. All students attending McGill-Toolen dances must pass a breathalyzer test before being admitted to the dance. A breathalyzer test may also be administered to students at any time during or after the dance.

Tickets will be sold the week prior to the dance at school for **\$5.00 per person**. The ticket price if purchased the night of the party is **\$10.00 per person. Please bring exact change (Cash Only.)** Snacks, drinks and pizza will be available for purchase at the concession stand. Neither the school nor any of its employees or agents will assume any responsibility or liability for items lost at the dance. Please remember there will be no coat check.

## **Hall Decoration Guidelines: Gym Foyer Only**

1. Decorate Gym Foyer only.
2. Please do not have "loose props" that may be moved around in the foyer. Props must be secured.
3. Please do not put tape on painted surfaces – It can and does pull the paint off of the walls. Use painter's tape.
