2. Must have at least a 3.2 GPA
3. Two-year varsity letterman
4. Essay required- Topic? Why do you deserve the Benny Edens Scholarship?

Evan Nash Memorial Scholarship

The Evan Nash Memorial Scholarship was set up by family and friends to honor the memory of Evan Nash. Evan was both an excellent student in the seminar program and an athlete on the cross-country team at Point Loma High School.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating from PLHS
2. Must have a GPA above 2.50
3. Member of the cross-country team

Jack Haskell Memorial Scholarship

Former head counselor Barbara Gorrow and friends of Mr. Haskell established this scholarship in October 1988. Mr. Haskell was a math teacher and counselor at Point Loma High School from 1959 to 1975. In his work with the students here, Mr. Haskell was often an unseen worker who gave extra time and concerns to those areas that could most benefit the students.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. A senior at PLHS
2. Must possess strong moral character and have achieved significant academic results despite economic or environmental hardships, or other unique circumstances
3. Exhibit special concern and care for fellow students and others
4. One letter of recommendation
5. One-page essay detailing your strength of character, and achievement of significant academic results despite economic or environmental hardships.

Lou Ghio PL Surf Scholarship

Awarded to Point Loma High senior, who has participated in either surf PE and/or the Point Loma High Surf team during their high school career.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating from PLHS
2. Must have a GPA above 2.50

Point Loma High School AVID Scholarship

Awarded to senior AVID students who have been a part of the PLHS AVID program for a minimum of 4 years, have maintained a minimum 9-12 WGPA of 3.0, and who will attend a four-year college in the fall.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Four-year AVID student
2. Must have a Weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Attending a four-year college this fall

Point Loma High School Math Department Scholarship

The math department at Point Loma High School has established this scholarship to reward and recognize an exemplary student who intends to make math an integral part of his or her life.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
2. Math GPA must be 3.5 or higher
3. Must be a senior at Point Loma High School
4. Recommendation from at least one math teacher.
5. Essay focused on how the student plans to use math in college, career, and life

Point Loma High School Spirit Awards

Offered by generous PLHS Alumni.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Recipient must be a college bound senior
2. Active in extra-curricular activities
3. 3.0 minimum GPA

Richard C. Ware Memorial Scholarship

Mr. Ware was a valuable member of the Solar Turbine Company for more than 30 years. After a valiant battle against cancer, he died in 1994, becoming an organ donor for those in greatest need. This scholarship was established in 1994 in his memory. Note: GPA, community/work experience, and college/vocational plans after high school will be taken into consideration.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Student has physical or learning disabilities
2. Student has college or vocational plans

William Lee Trepanier "Coach T" Memorial Scholarship

As an energetic math teacher and coach of women's basketball at Point Loma High School, Lee Trepanier was known as "Coach T." He led the Lady Pointers to a 335-51 record, winning four state championships. Coach T retired in 1990 after coaching 14 seasons.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Female graduating senior
2. Athletics or mathematics achievement
3. Must have a 2.0 GPA or higher
4. Demonstrate financial need
5. Write a brief paragraph - Topic: What have I gained from athletics (or mathematics)?

Larry Zeiger Film Arts Awards (There are eleven individual scholarships in this field)

The following awards are presented to outstanding senior students in the Cinematic Arts and Visual Arts programs at Point Loma High School.

***Please note: You may apply only if you have completed the Cinematic Arts and/or Video Production courses at Point Loma High and would like to be considered for any of the following awards.

Larry Zeiger Award

The Larry Zeiger Award is for outstanding student in Cinema Arts and/or Performance. Larry Zeiger, a former San Diego Teacher of the Year, who taught cinema arts and musical theatre at Point Loma High for 33 years and is also a composer, author, photographer, and currently is music director of the Act One Players of Clairemont and on the Board of Directors of the San Diego Children's Discovery Museum.

Eddie Hook Award

In Eddie Hook's memory and in celebration of his life, Class of 1978 he was an amazing singer, composer, lyricist, and family man. Eddie's music and kindness live on forever in all the lives he touched.

Jeremy Dawe Award

To celebrate Jeremy's life, Class of 1996, he was a young lawyer who was kind-hearted, hard-working, compassionate, dedicated, and a friend to all!

Dustin Esquivel Award

Class of 1993, Dustin was a creative artist and award-winning poet with a great sense of humor.

Karen Raffee Award

Class of 1977, Karen was a fantastic dancer of charm, grace, and beauty who performed in the very first Gotta Sing Gotta Dance production at Point Loma High.

Chris Little Award

Class of 1985, Chris was a wonderful father, poet, sportsman, educator, and friend to all.

Gia Kersulis Award

Class of 1997, Gia was an incredible opera and pop singer who thrilled audiences with her spectacular voice.

Burke Simpson Award

Class of 1981, Burke was a creative individual with a great sense of humor and compassion for others.

Chip Hungerford Award

Class of 1981, Chip was a wonderful singer, actor, humorist, and Pointer football star.

PLHS Alumni Zeiger Scholarship

Recognizes a student's participation in the areas of visual arts, performing arts, or film production and to further his/her education in any selected field.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Energetic participation for at least two years in one or more of the following areas: visual arts (including studio and graphic arts), performing arts (including theater, music and dance, or film production)
2. Applicant should submit single-sheet copies of awards they have won, or one photograph, CD, or DVD showcasing an artistic work they have created as an individual or as part of a team; maximum submission of four awards, CD's, DVD's, or photographs (none will be returned)
3. Applicant must have financial need

Chris Brinker Award

Chris Brinker, a graduate of Point Loma High Class of 1988, was a highly talented, creative and dedicated film producer of such classic films as THE BOONDOCK SAINTS and director of the exciting film, BAD COUNTRY. Following his passing in February 2013, Chris' family and friends were inspired to uphold his legacy by creating this foundation with his namesake to provide scholarships to promising students in high school. The CBFF scholarship entails a grant of money to aid students interested in pursuing filmmaking or related arts in college and professionally.

1. A PLHS Senior who demonstrates ethical leadership, strength of character, and faith in, and vision for, humankind
2. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
3. Must be involved in school activities, community service, or have work experience
4. Brief essay on how you demonstrate ethical leadership, strength of character, and faith/vision for humankind

PLHS Class of 1949 Classmates and Friends/Sports

Awarded to a student who has actively participated in sports at PLHS and who attended one of the original grammar schools in PL in 1949 (Specifically: Cabrillo, Dewey, Loma Portal or Ocean Beach) and is headed to a local College or University (SDSU, USD, UCSD, or PL Nazarene.) To assist with college education (books, tuition). Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to release of funds.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must have a 2.50 GPA or higher
2. Active in PLHS sports
3. Active within the community
4. Must show financial need
5. Must live in zip code 92106 or 92107
6. Essay- Topic: How will this scholarship benefit your college education plans?

PLHS Class of 1949 Classmates and Friends/Academics

David Wells (PLHS Class of '82) was the triumphant pitcher for the World Champion Toronto Blue Jays in 1992. That same year, he donated \$50,000.00 for the establishment of this scholarship. Each year, David Wells awards a scholarship to a Point Loma High School graduating senior who has been outstanding in sportsmanship, teamwork and "coachability."

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating senior at PLHS
2. Active in athletics (primary consideration to baseball)
3. Two or Four-year college plans
4. Financial need

Greg Hurder Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is in the memory of Gregory S. Hurder, who was a student at Point Loma High School and who excelled in football, baseball and music.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating senior at PLHS
2. Must have 3.0 GPA or higher
3. Involved in school activities
4. Involved in community activities
5. Submit a brief essay on, "How will you pursue your interest in music or athletics in the future?"

The Joy Lauderbach Memorial Scholarship

The family and friends of Mrs. Lauderbach have established this scholarship as a tribute to her life of service to students and the community. Mrs. Lauderbach was a tireless volunteer for many community organizations including the Correia Junior High School and Point Loma High School PTSA's. When she died of cancer in February 1996, at the age of 49, more than 700 friends attended her memorial in celebration of her life of service and friendship.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Average to above average in citizenship
2. Plans to attend college or post-secondary institution in the fall
3. Must have not received other substantial scholarship awards
4. Possess a positive attitude towards school and other students
5. Be considered a "good friend" and support person to other students
6. Write an essay on, "Why My Friends Are Important to Me, Why I am Important to My Friends."

Ken Stone Memorial Scholarship

The family of Ken Stone has established this scholarship as a tribute and an honor to his memory. Ken was an engineer and businessman, with a keen mind and loving heart.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating senior at PLHS, continuing education at a two or four-year college
2. Must have a 3.6 GPA or higher
3. Documentation of being involved in school activities, and taking high level math and science courses
4. Majoring in math or science in college
5. Submit an essay on your passion for math, science, or engineering

Lois Stone Memorial Scholarship

The family of Lois Stone established this scholarship in celebration of her 80th birthday. Her daughter, granddaughters, and grandson work as a counselor and teachers. A PLHS alumni is part of her family!

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Graduating senior at PLHS, continuing education at a two or four-year college
2. Must have a 3.4 GPA or higher
3. Documentation of being involved in school or community activities
4. AVID Student
5. Write a brief background statement and explain how the PLHS AVID program has impacted your life and plans for the future

Margaret Harvey Baseball/Softball Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a young woman who truly shows love for the game and is a great teammate. This scholarship will be awarded to a softball player.
Margaret Harvey Baseball/Softball Scholarship

Maxey Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 1994 by the Maxey Family to benefit a PLHS graduate who will pursue an education at SDSU.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Minimum 2.50 GPA or higher
2. Must have your Counselor's signature on the application, confirming you will attend SDSU in Fall 2019
3. Please include a brief statement citing community service, extracurricular activities, and employment history.
4. Essay- Topic: Your personal narrative (including financial status) and career goals

Pointer Brothers Class of 1966 Community Involvement Scholarship

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
2. Must have financial need
3. A male senior at PLHS
4. Essay required - Answer the question "Given the stress and pace of your life, how do you find the time and opportunities to help others, and what have you learned from it?"

Pointer Sisters Class of 1966 Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the women graduates of the PLHS Class of 1966. They would like to recognize a deserving young woman whose goal is to further her education by attending a four-year college in spite of financial challenges she may be facing.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must be a female senior; an "unsung heroine"
2. Must have a 3.5 GPA or higher
3. Two letters of recommendation from teachers and/or counselors
4. Must have financial need
5. Essay: Provide a short description about you and your goals

Spirit of Pointer Class of 1973 Scholarship

This award was established May 2011 with the purpose of reinforcing in students' minds the value of the alumni connection and the history of Point Loma High School in which they play a part. One student will be awarded this scholarship each year. Point Loma High School Pointer Association membership is recommended, but not mandatory.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must be a senior that will be attending a four-year college or university in the Fall of 2018
2. Active in school activities
3. Submit a brief essay - What will being a Pointer Alum mean to you as you move through life?
4. Submit a short description about yourself and your goals

Point Loma High School Pointer Association Scholarship

The Pointer Association, an all-volunteer organization, supports the academics, athletic and arts of Point Loma High School. This scholarship is awarded to a student who appreciates the value of volunteering and plans to volunteer in support of education in the future.

Criteria for scholarship:

1. Essay required:

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Must have a 2.75 GPA or higher

2. Must have played one or more CIF sanctioned sports at PLHS for a total of three seasons

3. Must have exhibited a continuing record of good sportsmanship throughout your PLHS career

4. Must show proof of community service

Point Loma Kindness Project

To recognize a student who has demonstrated initiative to participate in community service on a regular and reoccurring basis.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. PLHS Senior with a 2.75 GPA or higher

2. Provide signed/verified log or letter of community service or project hours

3. One letter of recommendation (LOR) from a community service sponsor

The Jeremy Hayes Dawe Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial support for college to a Seminar student who has demonstrated a love of reading classic literature, history, or philosophy.

Criteria for this scholarship:

1. Community service
2. One letter of recommendation
3. Submit a brief essay about a work of classic literature, history, or philosophy which has influenced your way of looking at the world
