The P.E.O. Sisterhood is an international Philanthropic Educational Organization that promotes educational opportunities for women through grants, loans and scholarships. This scholarship is provided by P.E.O. Chapter S in Pullman, Washington, for a full-time or part-time female student in the fall of the academic year following high school graduation.

Student Criteria for Eligibility

Senior females who will be a 2019 Pullman High School graduate, age 20 or less on application deadline, who:

- Plans to attend an accredited post-secondary 2 or 4-year educational institution in the United States as a part-time or full-time student in the fall of the academic year following her high school graduation
- Exhibits excellence in leadership, extracurricular activities, community service, academics and potential for future success.
- Has a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States
- Must submit a transcript

Amount of Scholarships (\$1500)

This is a non-recurring scholarships in the amount of \$1500 to be used for tuition at an accredited college or university during the 2019 fall semester. The scholarships award will be paid directly to the institution on behalf of the successful applicant.
