ISTEP GRADUATION EXAM - MANDATORY TEST FOR ALL 10TH GRADERS

The Indiana Department of Education requires all 10th grade students, as a part of the graduation requirements, to take an English and Math exam. The state of Indiana sets the testing windows for these exams, so it is **CRITICAL** that your 10th grade student is present during testing days.

Please avoid taking your student out of school or scheduling appointments next week Wednesday, February 27 and Thursday, February 28, so that they can attempt the required exams.

All 10th graders will test morning and afternoon on Wednesday, February 27 and Thursday, February 28. Students need to bring a charged iPad both days.

Together we will work to make sure your student meets all the graduation requirements necessary. The ISTEP exam is an important part of this process.

CAFETERIA LUNCH ACCOUNT INFORMATION

Shelbyville High School is dedicated to the health and well-being of our students. We recognize the positive correlation between providing nutritious meals and a student's ability to learn.

Because of this, we want to make sure that parents are aware of our corporation policy.

Our policy states that students who have a negative balance in their My Schools Bucks account or do not have other forms of meal payment for their students (unless qualified for Free and Reduced status), will be given an alternative lunch option.

Students should no longer go through the lunch line and charge a meal.
