Jackson Parish feeding program will not start on March 30th due to health concerns for staff and community.

After conferencing with the State Department of Education and multiple school districts, in an effort to keep our staff and the public safe and healthy, we are choosing to use Emergency Meals to You through Baylor University to provide meals to our students during this crisis time. This option will leave parents of qualified students a choice to have meals delivered directly to their homes each week. Qualifying students should receive approximately 10 meals per week (breakfast and lunch for 5 days). The State Department is working diligently at this time to get this program up and running as quickly as possible.

Again, our number 1 priority is the health and safety of our staff and the entire community of Jackson Parish. We are following the governor's orders to quarantine and stay at home as much as possible.
