**ADDITIONAL MEALS**

- This Friday's meal pick up will include additional food to take home for the Spring Break week. Items such as boxes of cereal and jars of peanut butter will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Chips donated by Frito Lay will also be distributed.
- Our local service clubs (Rotary, Kiwanis, Lions and Optimist) are making plans to make dinners available during Spring Break. Look for the flyer at Friday's meal pick up for details.

## CONTINUE TO USE BEST PRACTICES FOR STAYING HEALTHY

- Frequent hand washing. Wash hands frequently, including fingertips, with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizers.
- Avoid large gatherings.
- Stay at home if you are ill. Call your doctor's office before going into the clinic. Avoid close contact with others who are sick. Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then immediately discard the tissue in the trash. Avoid touching eyes, mouth, and nose.
