May 24: Last day of classes and PTO sponsored picnic lunch

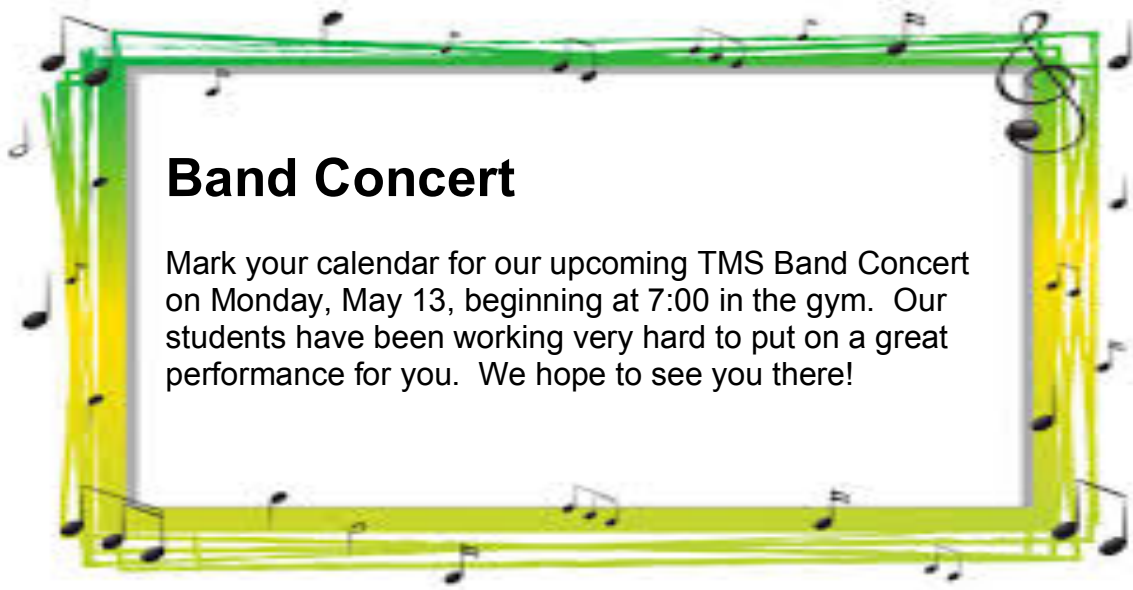

## **Sports Physicals**

If your student would like to participate in interscholastic sports during the 2019-2020 school year, please remember it is a requirement that a current sports physical is on file in the school office. Summer is a great time to take care of this requirement. Sports physicals are good for one calendar year.





## **School Fees**

Parents, please remember that any outstanding school fees have been carried over to the current year. They will continue to be carried over each year, building to building, until paid.

If your child is now approved for free lunches but the fees were assigned in a school year prior to being designated as free, the balance is still owed. The invoices you receive show the fees still owed from past years as well as the amount owed for the current year. Invoices were mailed home periodically throughout the year with grade cards.

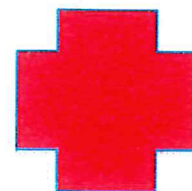
Interested students need to make sure they get a postcard from Mrs. Beaston with all of the necessary information to get started.

## SCHOOL NURSE NEWS



### Attention 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents

Dear Parent/Guardian of 6<sup>th</sup> grade student,

In order to minimize the spread of preventable illnesses and provide students with a healthier learning environment, the Board requires immunizations in compliance with the State law and the Ohio Department of Health for each student unless the parent(s) file an objection. Students failing to complete immunizations within 14 days after entering are not permitted in school.

The following immunizations are required for those entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade:

**Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis)**

**Meningococcal (Meningitis)**


Please contact your health care provider/clinic to see if your child has received these vaccines. If so, please send a copy of the immunization record to school.

If not, please call the Seneca County Health Department at 419-447-3691 Ext. 333 to schedule an appointment. Immunization clinics are only on Thursdays, please call **NOW** to ensure an appointment that is convenient for you.

Please call Tiffin Middle School if you have any questions or concerns at 419-447-3358 and ask for the school nurse.
