### Food Service Grant

Molly Spearman, State Superintendent of Education, recently announced that the Hampton School District One Office of Food Service was the recipient of the 2016-2018 Lunch Program Equipment Assistance Grant in the amount of \$17,000. **Mozelle Murdaugh, Director of Food Service**, wrote the grant to address and obtain much needed funding to replace broken or outdated commercial equipment at **Varnville Elementary School**.

Ms. Murdaugh will use the grant funding to purchase one of the most vital pieces of equipment used in meal preparation in many food service establishments, the Combination Oven Steamer. According to Ms. Murdaugh, "Having the new combination oven steamer will reduce Varnville's maintenance budget for repairing the existing outdated piece of equipment, increase productivity, and provide more preparation of healthy steamed and baked (instead of fried) meal choice options."

This sub-grant was funded by the US Department of Agriculture and administered by the South Carolina Department of Education's Office of Health and Nutrition.



### 10 Ways to Motivate Your Child to Learn

1. Fill your child's world with reading.
2. Encourage him to express his opinion, talk about his feelings, and make choices.
