New Business

- **PTC Board Voting**
 - **1st Vice President** – assists the President, engages in the promotion of the school children's welfare and all fund raising activities. In the absence of President, performs the duties of the President.
 - **2nd Vice President** – assists in organizing the school volunteers, room parents and assistants for each grade level through the approval of the President and Principal.
 - **Secretary** – keeps the minutes of all regular meetings.
 - **Treasurer** – responsible for receiving monies from school events, making a verbal and written financial report available at each meeting as well as annual report.

New Business Con't

- **Box Tops Collection** – Goal **\$600** to help purchase P.E. Equipment
 - Contest through **October 19th**
 - **First Place** – Pizza for the class plus pajama day. Teacher will receive a Personal Laminator along with 100 pouches.
 - **Second Place** – Donuts for the class. Teacher will receive a LapDesk.
