- 6. Presentations/Reports
 - 1. Walt Bratton City of Mabton Administrator presented the Parks needs assessment survey. The provision and operation of parks, cemetery and community services are important components of the city's immediate and long-range planning efforts. Information gathered from this survey will be used to create and adopt the firat ever Mabton 2016-2020 Parks, Community Services & Cemetery Comprehensive Plan. Survey will be available at the MSD schools, random mailings and posted in the community for city residents to complete. Board Member Wendy Morrow asked if her residence is within the boundary area. Mr. Bratton responded that it is not. Surveys can be dropped off at the City Hall from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Their office is closed from 12:00 noon to 1:00 pm. The city will also discuss the needs assessment survey at the Community Forum held in partnership with the Mabton School District. The community forum is scheduled to be held at the Learning Center on Thursday November 5th at 6:00 pm.
- 7. Superintendent Minerva Morales presented updates:

District Strategic Plan - Three weeks ago the district committee reconvened with the focus of the work being around Washington Transformational Professional Learning (Wa-TPL) professional learning standards. The committee engaged in a process to build common understanding on each standard: i.e., jigsaw activity, Freyer's Model, gallery walk. The group then prioritized the standards to determine a standard that will help drive the work of the strategic action plan forward. The professional learning standard that came to the forefront was that of "Implementation." More learning will continue at the reconvening of Wa-TPL in Wenatchee scheduled for November 2nd and 3rd, 2015.

Mabton School District/City of Mabton Community Forum – The purpose of this forum is for both entities to build awareness of project completions, current projects and upcoming projects. For Mabton School District, it poses an opportunity to continue gathering data that will assist in the process of identifying and prioritizing Capital Projects facility construction needs that will come before resident voters in November, 2016.

State Funding of Basic Education Working/Listening Tour – Superintendent Morales reminded the board of this event slated for October 27th, 2015 in ESD105 at 5:00 pm. Board Chair Elsa Sanchez and Elementary Principal Angie Ozuna will also be attending.

Mabton will also hold a Granger verses Mabton Volley Ball staff game. Proceeds will be donated to the Wapato food bank. Students are becoming familiar with new SRO Jessica Coles.
