Now What??

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- **Decide where you want to attend college**
  - ABAC <https://www.abac.edu/future-students/admissions/move-on-when-ready>
  - SRTC <http://southernregional.edu/high-school-students>
  
- **Take the SAT, ACT, or ACCUPLACER college entrance exams required for your college if you have not done so yet.**
  - Different programs could require different tests. You must take a college entrance exam and have your scores sent to the college. Please be aware of all registration deadlines.

  - SAT <http://sat.collegeboard.com/home>
  - ACCUPLACER Register to take at SRTC or see your school counselor

- 1. Schedule an advisement conference for you, your parent/guardian, and your school counselor by deadline. See back.**

Call (229) 387-2475 Ext. 8513 (Counseling Office) to schedule a mandatory advisement meeting with your school counselor. You and your parent/guardian must attend this mandatory advisement session, where you will complete required paperwork, discuss college course options, high school graduation requirements, and update your individualized graduation plan. Student will receive a Dual Enrollment Schedule Request Form (pink copy).

- 2. Apply to ABAC or SRTC if you have not already applied**

Provide supporting materials (transcript, immunization, etc.) to college Admissions Office. There may be an application fee.

## **Summer 2019:**

SAT- last acceptable test option-**Dec. 1, 2018** (Register by Nov. 2, 2018)  
ACT- last acceptable test option- **Dec. 8, 2018** (Register by Nov. 2, 2018)  
Meet with your school counselor- **Feb. 1 - Feb. 28, 2019**  
Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **March 20, 2019**

**BRIDGE Parent Conference Day is March 1, 2019. Be sure to select "Dual Enrollment" courses during the Registration process.**

## **Fall 2019**

SAT- last acceptable test option-**Dec. 1, 2018** (Register by Nov. 2, 2018)  
ACT- last acceptable test option- **Dec. 8, 2018** (Register by Nov. 2, 2018)  
Meet with your school counselor- **Feb. 28 – March 22, 2019**  
Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **April 30, 2019**

## **Spring 2020:**

SAT- last acceptable test option-**Aug. 25, 2019** (anticipated date)  
ACT- last acceptable test option- **Sept. 7, 2019** (anticipated date)  
Meet with your school counselor- **Feb. 28 – March 22, 2019**  
**Meet with your school counselor again- Sept. 26-Oct. 31, 2019**  
Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **Dec. 4, 2019**
