Growth Mindset for Parents – Part 6

Learning and the brain:

–Talk about neural networking. Ask your child what he or she has learned in school about the brain.

–Whenever you hear our child say “I give up” or “I just don’t get this,” remind your child to visualize neurons connecting every time he learns something new. Encourage your child to work hard and practice new skills and concepts so that he can develop strong neural connections in his brain.

–Share with your child some things that you have not yet mastered and your plan for practicing and building stronger connections in your brain.

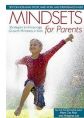
Dual Immersion – Parent Meeting
