

Perez Elementary Coordinated Dress Code

J.R. Perez Elementary School wants to ensure that all students are in compliance with campus-coordinated dress no later than one week after beginning school and/or upon enrollment. The District's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruptions, instill discipline, minimize safety hazards, and teach respect for authority. Please ensure your child is in compliance with Perez' dress code.

Note that the principal shall be accorded the authority/discretion to rule on whether any article of clothing, etc. is acceptable for uniform wear. This shall include items not specifically covered in the handbook. Please contact the school if we can be of any assistance.

The coordinated dress will consist of:

- **Khaki long pants with belt loops.** (No Cargos, Baggies, or Overalls)
*PreK4 – 1st Grade: **Khaki** long pants with elastic waist
*2nd – 4th Grade: **KHAKI** long pants with belt loops
- **Khaki walking shorts with belt loops** (No Cargos, Baggies, or Overalls – Must be to the top of the knee)
Pre-K4, K, and 1st Grade may wear walking shorts with elastic waist.
- **Khaki skirts or skorts** (Must be to the top of the knee. Shirts must be tucked at all times.)
- **Khaki jumpers** (Must be to the top of the knee.)
- **Royal Blue polo style shirt** – {No logos or symbols}
(On Thursdays, "Spirit Day", students may wear Perez spirit shirts, but they must say "Perez" or Perez Cadets, KISD Perez Ballet Folkloric, or KISD UIL on them.)
- **Belt** (Must be always worn and waist size – No excessive length)
- **Coats/Jackets** – Must follow dress code as set by the school district dress code
- **Shoes** – Must follow dress code as set by the school district dress code (Shoes or boots with steel toes, and noisemaking devices, and shower shoes are prohibited. Sandals must have straps; no flip flops)

GUIDELINES

- Students must be in compliance one week after school starts
- Grace period for students who enter late in the year – One (1) week to comply with dress code
- If a student is anytime non-compliant, parents may be contacted and/or "clothing replacement" may be offered to student.
