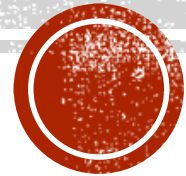

# THE HUNTING GROUND - GROUND RULES

In this session we will watch a documentary on the prevalence of sexual assault on College Campuses. Survivors will describe their assaults.

- This will require the highest level of maturity.
- We will not engage in any victim blaming.
- Racism, Sexism & Homophobia are never allowed.

# **MANDATED REPORTING**

As a reminder all adults on this campus are mandated reporters. If a student discloses a sexual assault it must be reported.



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Sexual Harassment - unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors, and verbal or physical harassment in the workplace or learning environment

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Sexual Assault -sexual contact that occurs without consent

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Rape - a form of sexual assault, sexual penetration without consent

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1 in 16 male students will  
be assaulted in college

# CONSENT

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California requires affirmative consent — affirmative, conscious and voluntary agreement to engage in sexual activity — throughout the encounter, removing ambiguity for both parties. The law protects both partners by ensuring a mutual understanding.



A person who is incapacitated by drugs or alcohol cannot give consent.







Break the Silence - share what you have learned

Know your rights - United States Federal Law guarantees students the right to an education free from sexual violence and harassment.

Campus Culture - enact a culture of respect, practice bystander intervention by speaking out when you see or hear abusive behavior

Be an Ally - support survivors
