Dear Inglewood Unified School District community,

Following Governor Gavin Newsom's and Los Angeles County officials' announcement on Thursday, March 19, of a new public health order for people to stay home to increase social distancing, the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE) announced the recommendation to close all schools in Los Angeles County with students returning on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, to limit the community spread of COVID-19.

In alignment with these recommendations, Inglewood Unified will continue with the closure of all schools for students, extending until Tuesday, May 5, 2020.

I will be communicating more detailed information next week. The IUSD Board of Education and I cannot thank you enough for your care and dedication during this difficult time.
