Nominees

The nominee must:

- have completed a minimum of three years of teaching experience within The District
- be an exceptionally skilled, knowledgeable and dedicated teacher
- be a facilitator of learning; implementing creative teaching strategies
- have a superior ability to teach and to inspire a love of learning in all students
- engage in self-directed professional development and lifelong learning
- demonstrate leadership through active participation in the school and community
- have the respect and admiration of students, parents and colleagues
- be poised, articulate, enthusiastic, and energetic
