Elementary Open House



It is almost time to send them back! The Hempfield Area School District looks forward to welcoming your children back for the 2019 - 2020 school year. This year the district's elementary schools will be hosting the Elementary Open Houses on August 20, 2019. The evening will begin at 5:30 pm and run to 8:00 pm. Parents and students entering grades K - 2 are asked to visit the schools between 5:30 pm - 7:00 pm. Parents and students entering grades 3 - 5 are asked to visit their schools between 6:30 pm and 8:00 pm. We have allowed for the overlap of time during the middle of the evening (6:30 pm - 7:00 pm) for any parents who may have students in both grade spans.

To assist in the parking situation during the events, we ask parents to be cognizant of their assigned times. Also, parking attendants will be on site at all the buildings. The three schools with the smallest parking lots will have shuttle service provided to eliminate any possible congestion. Those schools are:

- *West Point Elementary* - a shuttle will run from Wendover Middle School's (425 Wendover Jr. High Road) parking lot to the school
- *Fort Allen Elementary* - a shuttle will run from Harrold Middle School's (1368 Middletown Road) parking lot to the school
- *Maxwell Elementary* - a shuttle will run from Greensburg Garden and Civic Center (951 Old Salem Road) parking lot to the school

The Open House is designed for all current and any new elementary students entering the Hempfield Area School District. The goal of Open House is to allow parents and students to have an opportunity to meet teachers before the school year officially begins. The students will be able to see their classroom(s) and get a quick overview of class expectations and the year's curriculum.

Student homeroom assignments will be mailed for all incoming kindergarten and new students; while all other students will be able to find their homeroom assignments posted on the Skyward site: students entering grades 1 - 5, August 16th.

The district will be utilizing the Remind communication application this school year for communications. Parents will receive an official invite from the system on August 19th based on the contact information we have on file. If you do not receive a message, please check your spam account.
