The Program

- Two and one half hour program, five days per week
- Two half-day sessions offered:
 - AM 8:52—11:32
 - PM 12:45—3:20
- Five days per week, following the school calendar
- Certified, full-time teacher and teacher assistant
- Language rich, literacy based classroom
- Students will have opportunities to learn in large and small group activities
- Hands-on experiential approach
- Learning through play



Eligibility

- Students must be 4 years old on or before December 1, 2018
- Children who turn 5 prior to December 1, 2018 are not eligible
- Children will be randomly selected for the program using a lottery system as per New York State guidelines
- A waiting list will be maintained should there be more interest than we have available slots

Parent Involvement

- Parents are partners in their child's learning
- Parents participation as volunteers is highly valued

Cost and Transportation

- Free to Bloomfield district residents
- Bus transportation provided to school for AM program and home for PM program. The District does not provide transportation home from the AM program or to school for the PM program.
