**GIRLS GOLF** – The Girls placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at this week’s WIAA 4A Golf Championships, played at Hangman Valley Golf Course. On day-one at The Creek at Qualchan, **Tanner Graybeal** shot 82, **Matt Jones** 83, **Caden Martensen** 90 and Jordan Mulder shot 98. The boys finished 12<sup>th</sup> as a team.
