San Joaquin Farm Bureau Scholarships: various scholarships. Deadline Mar 1, 2018. Applications in Counseling Office (GHS) or Dr. Chavez (LRHS) and on the schools' websites.

-Young Farmers and Ranchers: Award: minimum of \$2500. Demonstrated commitment to agriculture, possess leadership, and will be majoring in agriculture or related field.

-Agricultural Employees: Award: \$2000. Parent/guardian must be employed by an agricultural operation (farm laborer, packing shed, processing operation, PCA's, ag lenders, salesman/woman, etc) in San Joaquin County. Must possess determination to succeed, leadership, commitment to agriculture, desire to obtain higher education

-San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation: Award: \$2000. Parent/guardian must be a voting member of San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation. Student majoring in agriculture or related field.

-Robert J. Cabral Memorial Junior College Scholarship: Award: \$1000. For any student entering Delta College or Modesto Jr. College and pursuing a career in agriculture or educational field. Award based on leadership, commitment to success, and career goals

-Robert J. Cabral Memorial Education Scholarship: Award: \$2000. For students wishing to pursue a major in Education field. For students going to 4-yr universities and colleges

-Robert J. Cabral Memorial Agricultural Scholarship: Award: \$2000. Those pursuing a career in the agricultural industry. For students going to 4-yr colleges and universities.

-Raymond Camera Memorial Scholarship: Award: \$1000. For students entering a 4-yr university and pursuing a career in a scientific or technical field that will be used to benefit agriculture (ex: engineering, soil/plant science, irrigation science/technology)

-Mike and Eleanor Gikas Memorial Scholarship: Award: \$2000. For those entering community college or 4 yr university and pursuing a career in agriculture. Leadership, commitment to success, and career goals will be considered

-Alexander Hildebrand Memorial Scholarship: Award: \$2000. For those entering a 4-yr college or university and pursuing a career in a scientific or technical field that will be used to benefit agriculture. Criteria include: gpa, test scores, difficulty and achievement level in academic courses, determination to succeed, leadership

-Roy Mazzanti Memorial Agricultural Scholarship: Award: \$500. Students entering a 2- or 4-yr college and will pursue a career in agriculture.

-Bruce and Barbara Mettler Memorial Scholarship: Award: \$1000. For students entering a 4yr college or university pursuing a career in agriculture and has been involved in their community.

-The Clifford Dale Wunsch Memorial Scholarship: Award: \$2500. For students entering 2- or 4-yr college and plans to study agriculture. **DUE MAR 31, 2019**

Gary Simas Agricultural Scholarship: Award: \$500 (community college); \$1000 (4-yr): For students attending Delta College or Modesto Jr. College and those attending 4-yr colleges studying agriculture. Will need letters of recommendation and personal statement

-American AgCredit Scholarship: Award: \$2000. For students entering 4-yr universities majoring in agriculture and has been involved in their communities.
