We are looking forward to a wonderful **2019-2020** school year and are requesting voluntary donations. Every student will be provided with the necessary classroom supplies, regardless of whether you donate items.

First Grade Supply List for 2019-2020

1. Collected at Back to School Night: Please DO NOT write your child's name on the following donations. They will be used by the whole class.

- (3) reams of white copy paper.
- (1) box of **sharpened** #2 pencils.
- (1) watercolor paint set. (No more than 8 colors) **"Crayola"** brand is preferred.
- (2) **paper** folders; 2 pockets, with 3 metal prongs to hold 3 hole punch papers.
- (2) **plastic** folders; 2 pockets (No metal prongs).
- (2) boxes of tissue.
- (2) packs of Expo dry erase markers (not thin), 4 count each.
- (1) pack of Crayola Markers, classic colors
- (4) large glue sticks (**"Avery"** brand is preferred. Other brands do not stick well).
- (1) box of **24** crayons. (**"Crayola"** brand crayons are preferred). Please do not send larger boxes.

2. For the first day of school: inside "SPACEMAKER" pencil box, size 8" x 5" (available at Walmart, Dollar Tree, etc). No zippers please. These items are kept at school.

- (1) pair of scissors (**"Fiskar"** brand is preferred) with name written on blades in permanent marker.
- (2) pink erasers. Please write child's name across the middle of eraser with a ball point pen.
- (1) box of **24** crayons. Nothing larger. (**"Crayola"** brand crayons are preferred).
- (1) 4 oz. bottle of white glue (**"Elmer's"** white glue is preferred. No clear glue.)

3. It will also be helpful if your child has a:

- ❖ Backpack (a **non-rolling** backpacks are preferred because of schools stairs and tripping hazards). Write student's name in permanent marker.
- ❖ Small bottle of hand sanitizer to be kept in their backpack/lunch box.
- ❖ Lunchbox (if needed for snacks or lunch)
- ❖ Reusable water bottle with student's name in permanent marker.

4. Other Important Information:

- ❖ Put your child's name on tags inside all jackets, sweaters, and sweatshirts.
- ❖ Students should be able to tie their shoes, zip pants and jackets, button sweaters, and use a safety pin.
