Westport Community Schools will begin providing “grab-and-go” breakfast and lunches for all Westport children beginning Friday, March 20 from 10:00 am to 11:00 am. Beginning next week, we will hand out “grab-and-go” bags, Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10:00 am to 11:00 am. Pick up area will be at the Westport Jr Sr High School where cars will line up in the bus area and staff will hand bags to the students in their vehicles. Students MUST be present! If you know of children or families with no access to transportation we will deliver to a local area near their home. This is for all children living in Westport under the age of 18, they do not have to attend Westport Schools.
