

Summit Academy Parents and Students,

Governor Herbert ordered the suspension of all on-campus classes for public schools for a period of two weeks. All on-campus classes at Summit Academy will be taught online until March 30th. During this time, students should not be at the school, unless they have been invited for specific reasons. Students will be expected to continue their education using online and other resources. Teachers are working on converting their classes to either Google Classroom or Canvas. These classes will be available online starting Wednesday, March 18th. Instructions on how to access these classes will be sent out no later than Tuesday.

While Summit Academy will do everything it can to continue to provide your child with a quality education, it is reasonable to understand that online classes are not a direct replacement for in-class instruction. We look forward to having students return as soon as state health authorities make that decision.

Below are more detailed instructions and expectations:

Attendance, Assignments, and Grades

It is important that students and families understand that Summit Academy is not closed. Classes will continue. Teachers will be providing instructions and giving assignments on-line. Students will be expected to check in with their teachers each day and complete their assignments. These assignments will be graded.

Access to Technology

All online resources will be accessible using computers, chromebooks, or smartphones. If families are in need of technology, the schools will have chromebooks available for checkout. Please call your student's school on Monday to make arrangements to checkout a chromebook.

Special Education Services

Students with IEPs will continue to receive the services outlined in their IEP. Our staff will be reaching out to parents early next week to outline how these services will continue. Receiving these services may require students to come to the school as determined by their file holder.

School Lunches

We will continue to provide lunches for all students, which can be picked up at our Independence Campus each day between 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. The address is 15327 S. Noell Nelson Drive in Bluffdale.

Sports and Activities

All sports and activities, including practices, have been canceled until March 30th.

Scheduled Testing

We are working with the State Office of Education to reschedule state mandated testing. This includes the ACT scheduled for all 11th grade students previously scheduled on March 24th.
