FRIDAY, May 31- 10:00 AM

BRUNCH FOR ACADEMIC 4.0 and above: 10:00 AM in the cafeteria. A delicious brunch is served to the academic 4.0 and above students and their parents. This event is by invitation only. Students in this group are eligible to audition to deliver the Valedictory Address at graduation on May 23rd. See Mrs. Thompson to sign up.

MONDAY, JUNE 3- 6:00 PM

SENIOR AWARDS NIGHT: 6:00 PM in the auditorium. This event is a very special evening for El Segundo High School seniors. Typically over \$45,000 is awarded in scholarships to El Segundo High School students sponsored by community businesses, service clubs, former ESHS graduating classes, etc. Should a student receive a scholarship, they will be invited to attend prior to the event.

MONDAY, JUNE 3 – FRIDAY, JUNE 7 (4th period)

FINAL EXAMS: Seniors will take final exams. There will be no special schedule; exams will be given during regular class time. ALL senior finals must be done by 4th period on Friday! Locker clean-out will need to be done by the end of day June 7th.

FRIDAY, JUNE 7

SENIOR WALK through Richmond Street School or Center Street School: Take a walk down memory lane and inspire the next generation of Eagles. **CAP AND GOWN DISTRIBUTION** will take place at approximately 12:15 in the Auditorium. You will put yours on and walk as a large group to RSS (1:00pm) or CSS (1:15pm) where their student body and staff will be expecting you for your “senior walk”. Students who did not attend either school are encouraged to pick a school to walk through. This is the 4th annual walk! It is AWESOME!

Immediately following the walk, return to ESHS for your FREE **SENIOR BBQ** in the N. Quad!

BACCALAUREATE PRACTICE/GRAD TICKET DISTRIBUTION:

Seniors should report back to the auditorium **AT 2:45 PM** for a quick meeting and to receive their graduation tickets. **Each student will receive SIX graduation tickets.** Any tickets that will not be used should be turned in to Mrs. Thompson in the Main office. Parents can request additional tickets in writing. This letter should be submitted to the Activities Office attention: Mrs. Espinoza- **by May 31st at 3:00 PM. Please note that additional tickets will likely be on the field NOT in the stadium.** Baccalaureate practice will commence following the distribution of tickets. Practice lasts approximately 45 minutes.

SATURDAY, JUNE 8-

GRAD NITE will be held at Disneyland and Disneyland CA Adventure on Saturday, June 8th. Busses will leave ESHS at 12:00 pm and return early the next morning. Grad Nite ends at 2am. This is a trip planned and led by

graduating senior class officers and senior parents. Season passes cannot be used. All students must ride to and from on the bus.

SUNDAY, JUNE 9

BACCALAUREATE: Seniors are asked to report to the front steps of the high school at 3:30 PM. The Baccalaureate will take place in the high school auditorium at 4:00 PM. Seniors are to wear their cap and gown and graduation clothing.

MONDAY, JUNE 10

NO SCHOOL for Seniors only, BUT a chance to tie up loose ends (pay fines, turn in books, electronics, etc.)

TUESDAY, JUNE 11

SENIOR CLASS PICNIC: A fun-filled day of activities including boating, carnival rides, softball, horseshoes, mini golf, volleyball, basketball and more. A DJ will be present. The students will be transported to Oak Canyon private park located in the hills of Orange County by bus leaving ESHS at 8:00 AM and should arrive back at the school at approximately 3:00PM. The cost will be \$45 w/ASB and \$50 w/o ASB. Students must sign up in the Activities Office w/ permission slip. The cost also includes a great menu (BBQ chicken, burgers, hot dogs, fruit, salad, cookies, etc.), soft drinks during the entire day and unlimited snow cones and popcorn. ☺ Dress is casual. Bathing suits are ok. Bring sunscreen and a towel! Tickets on sale May 28-June 6 at 3pm.

FRIDAY, JUNE 14

SENIOR CAP AND GOWN GROUP PICTURE: All seniors who wish to be in the group picture are to report to the front steps of the high school promptly at 4:30 PM. If you are not on time, you will not be in the picture. The picture will be taken at exactly 5:00 whether you are present or not. Payment envelopes will be passed out at one of the graduation practices or can be picked up in the Activities Office.

COMMENCEMENT: Line up for processional. All seniors are to be in the South Gym and lined up in their appropriate places at 5:30 PM for the graduation ceremony. During the ceremony we ask parents not to leave their seats to stand at the railing to take pictures or video. We ask that you extend courtesy to those people sitting behind you. The Senior Class has arranged for a photographer to take individual pictures as you receive your diploma which will be mailed to you.

****Graduation starts at 6:00PM sharp. ONLY school sanctioned attire is permitted at graduation (ex: ASB stole, AVID cord, Pathway stole, Spanish stole, etc.). Ask Mrs. Espinoza if you have any questions.**

Attire suggestions are:

Dress, skirt and blouse, or slacks.

Low heels, sandals, flats, or wedges recommended. **No stilettos as they may puncture the turf.**

Long pants, dress shirt or sport shirt with collar; tie optional.

Dress shoes and dark socks recommended.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT GRADUATION: Helium balloons, air horns, stadium chairs, beach balls, noise makers, blankets, strollers, beach chairs, ice chests, skateboards, and posters. Thank you!
