Be Informed: Use Proper Online Behavior



Say:

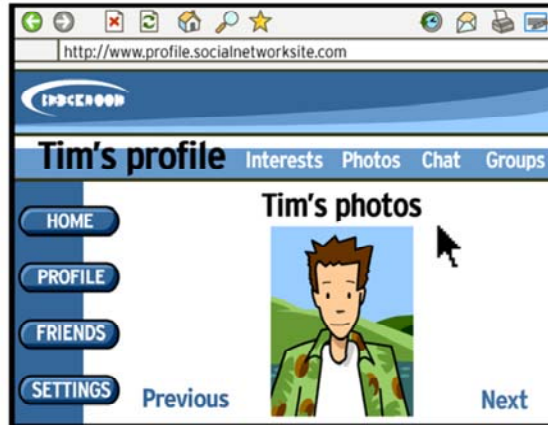
When you are on the internet, you should use good online behavior

Say:

Having good online behavior means

- Using positive words
- Being nice
- Telling the truth

Be Cautious: Social Networking Websites



Manage your personal settings responsibly.

Say :

“Can you “talk” to people on the internet?”

allow students to respond

Say:

“There are websites that people can go to and “talk” or share ideas. Those places are called social networks”

You should get a trusted adult’s permission before going to a social network
look at the picture on this slide. This is an example of a social network”

Say:

“You should tell a trusted adult if someone makes you feel sad, scared or confused when talking online.”

Be Aware: Online Personal Safety

- DON'T give out your real name
- DON'T share your phone number
- DON'T share your birth date
- DON'T give out your address
- DON'T share passwords
- DON'T share school name or after school clubs

Make sure your parents are aware of what you are doing online.



Say:

You should never give out information like:

Whole first and last name

Phone number

Birth date

Address

Passwords

School schedule or school clubs

Say:

Look at the picture. Is it ok to give your home address out to your online pals?

***Allow students to answer**

Say:

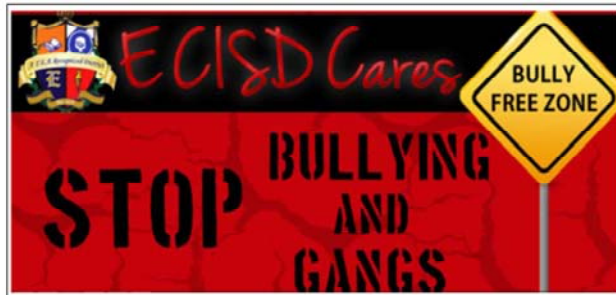
No, it is never ok to share your home address with online pals.



Say:

- Ignore texts from people they don't know
- If someone else posts hurtful or inappropriate messages -- do not respond, but do tell a teacher, parent or other adult
- Do not post hurtful or inappropriate messages.
- Do save messages that upset you and show them to your teacher or parents.

Be Responsible: Report Cyber Bullying



Say:

You should never bully someone with technology. Bullying someone with technology is called being a cyber bully.

Here are some things that you should Never do on the internet:

- Never send rude or mean comments
- Don't pretend to be someone else
- Never scare someone online

If you or someone you know is being bullied you should :

- Ignore the bully, and then tell a trusted adult- Parent, Teacher.



Say:

Consider these questions when communicating online. Only send or post a message online to someone if you can answer YES to at least one of the following questions:

1. Is it true?
2. Is it helpful?
3. Is it inspiring?
4. Is it necessary?
5. Is it kind?
