Just as with a job, a certain amount of absences are reasonable before any actions take place. Once an excessive amount of absences begin happening, at some places of work, you get a letter of warning, a letter of reprimand, hours cut back, or fired.</i></p> <p><i>To help support attendance in school, and how that correlates to attendance in the workplace, a committee of students at Union gathered to discuss our attendance policies, procedures, and supports. Our policy was developed by our students wanting support while they learn to attend, better.
