- 3. Students that withdraw from school will be required to return any refunded scholarship money that will be deposited back into a designated scholarship account or returned directly to the donor of the scholarship.**
- 4. Students are expected and required to provide a written statement of progress/gratitude to the donor of the scholarship along with a copy of grades received at the end of each semester on any renewable scholarship.**
- 5. NO scholarship recipient under any circumstance is to solicit scholarship funding or additional monies as well as requesting scholarship money in advance from the scholarship donor.**
- 6. Scholarship money for the recipient will be paid directly to the institute of higher learning and NOT to the recipient.**
