

## **What's My FUTURE! Application**

### **Program:**

In conjunction with MAWI Learning, Hillside School is offering an after-school leadership program for 7th Grade students. This 10-week program is designed to help students learn skills to prepare them for the future. In addition, parents/guardians are required to participate in a 20 minute collaborative meeting to learn strategies to support their child (Translation services available for parents). All students will receive a My Future journal and a What's My Future program T-shirt.

### **Eligibility:**

All 7th grade students are eligible to apply for the program and are required to complete application process including an interview to be considered for admission. The maximum number of students that will be admitted to the program will be fifteen (15) 7th grade students.

### **Application:**

The application for the program **is due to the Main Office by January 11, 2019** and interviews will occur the following week. Students must complete all parts of the application packet, satisfactorily complete all pre-leadership activities and be approved by Hillside School before being chosen as a FUTURE student
