Duties

Teachers are responsible for planning and implementing quality-learning experiences, preparing semester plans and daily lesson plans, and creating a stimulating classroom environment conducive to intellectual discovery within a Deaf bilingual program. Teachers participate in the Individual Education/Individual Transition Plan process and integrate IEP/ITP activities into their lessons. They plan assessment activities that evaluate students' progress in relation to the Common Core Standards or the Alternate Curriculum and then prepare reports of student learning progress. Teachers integrate character education into their classes and are models of good citizenship. Positive relations with parents, students, and professional colleagues, continuous professional development, commitment to social justice, empowerment of families and support for diversity, and a spirit of collegiality and teamwork are expected. Commitment to ASL and English instruction within a Deaf-centered learning environment is critical to the success of the teacher and CSD. Teachers also participate in extra-curricular programs.

Qualifications

- 1) Possession of a California Standard Teaching credential authorizing the holder to teach Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing students;
- 2) Proficiency in American Sign Language;

- 5) Education and/or experience in one or more of the following areas: experience working with students from a diverse background; bilingual education, learning differences, team teaching, transition, project-based instruction, working with students with special needs.
