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### PreK Registration Required Documentation

Parents should bring the following documents with them to register their child for PreK. The registration process can not be completed without this information.

1. Birth Certificate
2. Social Security Card
3. Medicaid Card (if applicable)
4. Immunization Record (from Health Department)
5. Proof of Residency (to include one of the following items):
  - A. Utility Bill(s) with service address or
  - B. Lease/Rental Agreement

### PreK Registration Information

Pre kindergarten students will need to register at the new **Hampton School District One Learning Center** (Old Varnville Town Hall) located at **63 East Palmetto Avenue, Varnville, SC, on April 27, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.** Any child not registered that day will need to register at the Hampton School District One District Office located at 372 East Pine Street, Varnville, SC.

It is very important that PreK children register on April 27, 2017, in order to be signed up for a screening that will be given at a later date. Failure to register your child may result in your child being put on a waiting list. Hampton District One offers the Child Development Education Pilot Program (CDEP all day program).

To be eligible, children must qualify for free/reduced priced lunch or be Medicaid eligible. After the screening, children eligible for the program will be notified.

This district child development education pilot program offers: 1) small classes (low 10:1 pupil-teacher ratio, 2) specially trained teachers and assistants, 3) 6 ½ hour school day (free), 4) convenient 180 day school year, and 5) parenting support.
