Fennell Elementary Technology Center has been awarded a \$10,000 Grant from Coastal Community Foundation, the Beaufort Fund. This money will be used to fund the night school program this spring. The program began with the Technology Center opening on Wednesday the 16th of January from 6 to 8 p.m. The program will open every Wednesday through the end of May (except April 17th). During the Technology Center open sessions, there will be a teacher, Robbie White, and a teacher assistant, Latonya Murray, to help adults with projects they would like to complete. Adults can come in to work on basic computer literacy skills, typing, filling out job applications, printing posters or personal pictures and flyers for local churches and community events. K-12 students can work on homework, school projects, typing, as well as reading and math enrichment. The printing projects are free and paid for with the grant money. The center was also able to purchase 5 new iMac G5 computers with this money. Since 2016, Fennell Elementary Technology Center has been awarded \$36,745



from the Beaufort Fund and the Winthrop Fund of the Coastal Community Foundation, the Palmetto Electric Bright Ideas Grants, and from Community Foundation of the Lowcountry-Pearls of Hampton County Endowment



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
