Coronavirus Information For Parents

School Dismissal

At this time, our district will follow a three-week school dismissal for all students followed by one week for Spring break. School is expected to resume on Tuesday, April 14, 2020. If the district receives information regarding an extension of this time period, the district will notify all families and staff.

Continuity of Learning

In order to provide for the continuity of learning, the district is planning to provide remote learning through various platforms and packet learning for those families that do not have access to the Internet. Directions related to distance learning will be posted on the district website. Students with special needs with pre-scheduled IEPs will be held via telephone conference. All school related activities including sports activities, parent meetings, and field trips have been postponed during this time.

Access to School Meals

School meals will continue to be provided to all students within the school district, regardless of lunch eligibility. Breakfast and lunches will be provided at the following school sites: North Park Academy of the Arts, Rivera Middle, and STEAM Academy. There will be a 3-hour window, from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., for students to pick-up one sack which includes breakfast and lunch from the identified school sites. Meals will not be served on March 27, 2020 and from April 6-13, 2020 (spring break).
