Mr. Joyce Concerns

Mr. Dorsett Concerns

- Pink notes will no longer be used beginning on Monday, December 10. The process for tardy students will be discussed and communicated.

- Students are leaving the cafeteria during lunch and roaming the building. We have to work as a team to ensure that students are where they need to be.

- Student perception surveys will be shared with teachers as the data is released.
