Seton Hill University

Seton Hill University and Hempfield High School are working together to offer eligible students the opportunity to earn college credits through the College in High School (CHS) Program/Dual Enrollment. Register for one or more of the approved courses and upon successful completion of each course, you will receive college credit from Seton Hill University. The cost is \$225 per course and may be paid at the time of registration. Students enrolled are welcome to use the resources of Seton Hill's Reeves Memorial Library, either in person or online.

****Please note:** Tuition is not refundable if the student withdraws from a course. Also, If you are registering for a semester class, you must register in the semester you are taking the class. In other words, do not pre-register in the fall for spring classes.

Option 1: Online

To begin your online registration,

1. Go to grif.ly/CHSHempfieldArea and complete the form.
2. Follow the link to the Tuition Management System and make payment.
3. If payment is not made at the time of registration, a follow up email will be sent to the email address you provided with payment instructions. Once we receive your payment and the high school approves your registration, you will be emailed a copy of your Seton Hill schedule. This will complete your enrollment. Registration is open until September 27, 2019 for yearlong courses and Fall semester courses. Also, if a parent is registering for the student, please use student name, not parent name.

Option 2: Paper Application

Fill out the [paper application](#) and include credit card information or a check made to *Seton Hill University*. Bring registration form and payment to Mrs. Krivus in the Grade 11/12 office. Multiple courses can be listed on one application.

Cost: \$225 / course

Deadline: Year-long or Fall semester class- September 27, 2019

**All registrations made after September 27 will incur a \$50 late fee.

Online registration only

1. If you have taken a Dual Enrollment course with WCCC within the last two years, please begin at Step 2. If this is your first Dual Enrollment class with Westmoreland, please complete the free, online application at <https://apply.westmoreland.edu/Datatel.ERecruiting.Web.External/Pages/Welcome.aspx>. This will prompt you to create an account and then to complete the application. Your application must be submitted prior to registering for your Dual Enrollment course(s).
2. A Westmoreland County Community College representative will be present at Hempfield Area High School to assist with your Dual Enrollment registration on **September 24th** during homeroom period in the mini-theater. You must have your Parent Proxy form completed and signed by a parent or guardian. This form will be available in the 11/12 office in mid-September. You will need to bring your Parent Proxy form with you when you meet with the Westmoreland representative at the high school to be properly registered for your Dual Enrollment course(s).

However, if you would like to register for your Dual Enrollment course(s) on your own, please complete the online registration form for Hempfield Area High School with a parent or guardian at <https://westmoreland.edu/academics/college-now/college-in-high-school.html>. Please click "Hempfield" and complete the online registration form. Only one

form is needed – you may check off all desired courses before submitting the form. Also, if a parent is registering for the student, please use student name, not parent name.

3. Check your Westmoreland portal at MyWestmoreland to check your registration and balanced owed.

Cost: \$147 / course (\$49.00 per credit) Westmoreland County Community College will bill you directly. Please watch your mail/email for notices.

Continue the process in its entirety. If parent is registering for the student, please use student name ,not parent name. The student will also provide an email address for their parent or guardian to provide consent and payment by echeck or credit card. Select classes and make sure to click on “register” to initiate registration. Once registered, a notification will be sent to the assigned Hempfield teacher to verify.
