Macro - Yes. The work includes a summary of the Fed's monetary report and reading and outlining a few chapters in the *Dead Econ* book.

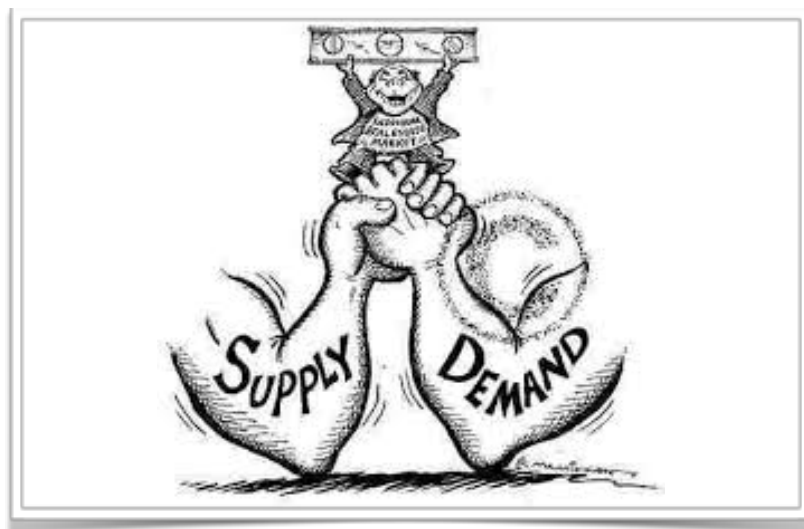
Micro - There is no summer work.

Course Information

Macroeconomics is the study of large-scale economic systems. We cover topics that affect whole societies such as GDP, inflation, unemployment, and aggregates.

Microeconomics is the study of individual decision-making units such as a firm or household. Topics of study include demand, supply, utility, profit maximization, and market structures. Macroeconomics is a pre-requisite for this course.

Both courses include extensive graphing. It is highly recommended that students take both courses if possible. Scores tend to be higher if both courses are taken due to the continued practice of economic skills.

Taking Macroeconomics only will fulfill your 0.5 credit Economics requirement for graduation.
