A place for students to *CONNECT* their learning in a hands-on collaborative format.

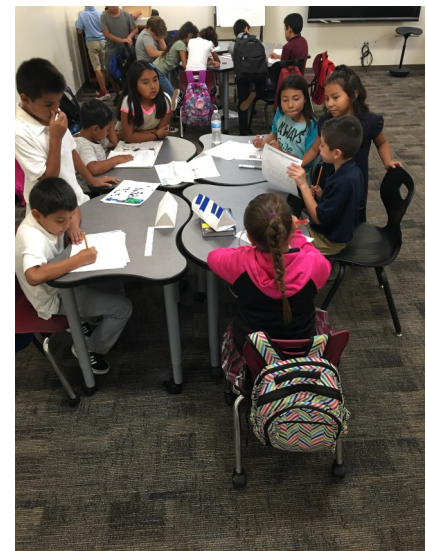


San Antonio Students Practice Their STEM Skills!

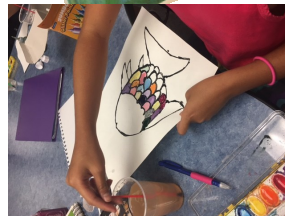
Homework Helpers at Washington
