

# HONORS POLICY

1. All students with a A- or better in a standard academic course may apply to take up to two Honors courses and may continue to remain in a maximum of 2 Honors courses for the duration of their time at Metro as long as they maintain a B+ average in all their courses, including their Honors classes. You must have earned an A- or above in the course you are applying for as Honors. If that average is not maintained in any given semester, the student will be removed from all Honors courses for the next semester.
2. Freshmen may only take a maximum of 2 Honors courses.
3. Sophomores who took 2 Honors courses freshman year who wish to take 3 their sophomore year must have a cumulative weighted A average/4.0 GPA from the previous semester to take 3 Honors courses.
4. Junior students may take up to 4 Honors courses if they have a cumulative weighted A average/4.0 GPA from the previous year.
5. Senior students may take up to 4 Honors courses if they have a cumulative weighted A average/4.0 GPA from the previous year.

## Special Notes:

1. Metro Arts does not recognize a valedictorian in the graduating class. Rather, we publicly recognize all High Honors (4.0 and above) and Honor (3.7-3.99) students at graduation. Class rank both weighted and unweighted will never be made public and will only appear on a student's transcript after graduation and after final grades have been submitted to the registrar.
2. Transfer students will be subject to the same requirements as above.
3. Registering for Honors Courses: Space is limited per instructor. Register as you do for electives with 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th choices by the deadline. If there are more students than spots available, Metro Arts will seat first come first serve based on when the Honors form was submitted.
