AFFORDABLE CARE ACT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Department of Treasury issued proposed regulations which allows an ALE to adopt the Look Back Measurement Method Safe Harbor to determine the status of an employee as full-time in accordance with the requirements of the ACA and Section 4980H; and

WHEREAS, Massena Central School District intends to enact processes necessary to make a good faith effort to comply with the requirements of the ACA Shared Responsibility for Employers; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, the Massena Central School District establishes the Standard Measurement, Standard Administrative, and Standard Stability Periods for current ongoing variable hour and/or seasonal employees as required by the ACA Shared Responsibility for Employers (Section 4980H) as follows:

Standard Measurement Period: July 1st to June 30th

Standard Administrative Period: July 1st to September 30th

Standard Stability Period: October 1st to September 30th
