

WEST MONONA COMMUNITY SCHOOL 2018-2019 REGISTRATION

Registration for ALL West Monona students will be held on **Tuesday, August 7th from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 pm in the high school commons.** Registration will include a required registration fee at all grade levels and additional fees for optional items such as snack milk and activity tickets. Middle School/High School registration requires paperwork to be filled out and signed by both the parent/guardian and the student so we encourage parents and students to attend together so the registration process can be completed in one visit. If desired, elementary parents/guardians may register their children without their child being present. If you are unable to register on August 7th and/or pick up your computer, please contact the office of the building in which each of your children attend to make other arrangements.

OPEN HOUSE

Open House will be held on Wednesday, August 22nd from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the elementary and from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the middle/high school.

HIGH SCHOOL COMPUTER DISTRIBUTION

Computers for all 9th through 12th grade students will be distributed at registration on Tuesday, August 7th at the high school building. At least one parent must accompany their student in order to receive their computer.

ORGANIZATION OF BUILDINGS

ELEMENTARY- Pre-kindergarten, Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th grades

MIDDLE SCHOOL -6th, 7th & 8th grades

HIGH SCHOOL - 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th grades

KINDERGARTEN REQUIREMENTS

All kindergarten children must be 5 years of age by September 15, 2018. Students must bring immunization certificates, dental screening and evidence of their physical, including blood lead testing. Those who have not pre-registered must also bring a copy of their birth certificate.

OPENING DAY

The school year will begin on Thursday, August 23rd, at 8:20 a.m. for all students and will be dismissed at 2:25 p.m. from the elementary and 2:30 p.m. from the middle/high school on the first day of school only.

SCHOOL MEALS POLICY/FEE WAIVER INFORMATION

Breakfast and lunch will be served with meals being prepared at both attendance centers. We will continue to serve good wholesome, nutritional meals with a variety of foods. Forms to apply for assistance with the cost of meals are distributed at registration and are also available in each of the school offices. Those who qualify for assistance will receive meal benefits when the application is returned and approved. You may elect to sign a fee waiver application if you would like to request a waiver of school fees. The waiver form is located on the back side of the meal application and should be signed when you return your meal application form.

ADMISSION PRICES FOR GAMES

Admission prices for home games and conference events are \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students.

A student athletic ticket covers admission to all home events except tournament games. The cost for a student ticket is \$55.00. Adult athletic tickets are also available for a cost of \$100.00.

West Monona School District residents who are 65 years of age or older are eligible for a free senior citizen pass to athletic events. Requests can be made in the Superintendent's Office at the high school.
