Health Room Information

The school has received notification of quite a few cases of pneumonia since the start of the school year. Most recently, several have been diagnosed with viral pneumonia in the kindergarten classes.

The most common symptoms of pneumonia are:

- Dry cough. The cough makes this a contagious illness. Please reinforce with your children to cough into their elbow and to wash their hands often.
- Fever, which may be mild or high
- Shaking chills
- Shortness of breath, which may only occur with exercise
- Loss of appetite, low energy, fatigue

Most people who develop pneumonia initially have symptoms of a cold. If you have any concerns about the health of your child, please contact your healthcare provider.
