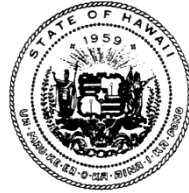

Penalties can range from detention to dismissal with the possibility of arrest and serious criminal charges. We wanted you to have the facts so you can discuss them with your child and emphasize the seriousness of this issue.

The well-being of everyone at Radford High is a continual community effort and your voice is a critical part in keeping our campus safe and secure. We need your help to remain vigilant and speak up immediately if you see something suspicious that could be a threat. Please remember, "If you see something, say something."
