GENERAL DUTIES

- Be knowledgeable about, and implement the schools district's assistive technology assessment procedures.
- Be knowledgeable about federal and state regulations and policies related to the consideration and implementation of assistive technology in Florida schools.
- Provide support to district teams conducting assistive technology assessment activities.
- Select the appropriate measurement tools and assist in assessment of students for assistive technology needs.
- Maintain current knowledge of assistive technology software and hardware to determine appropriate technology for system trials.
- Lead the assessment teams in understanding what the student needs relative to his or her abilities, educational goals, and environmental factors that relate to the selection and delivery of assistive technology devices and services.
- Interpret and present the results of assistive technology assessment to the IEP teams in a way that supports effective decision-making based on the student, the educational program, and the data gathered during the assessment process.
- Provide classroom support to ensure implementation and follow through as needed for assistive technology.
- Provide technical assistance regarding assistive technology and its implementation
