

**DRIVER INSTRUCTION**

Students will qualify for, and enter into, the driver instruction sequence based on chronological age and demonstration of a high level of reliability and responsibility. Reliability and responsibility will be determined by the following:

1. School Attendance: Students must attend school regularly.
2. School Achievement: Students must have earned 55 units of high school credit.
3. School Behavior: Students must maintain a record of good conduct.

Continuance in the driver instruction sequence will be based also on reliability and responsibility as outlined above.

Prior to each semester, the assistant principal will meet with the district driver training coordinator to determine the order of entry into the driver instruction sequence for the ensuing semester based on the criteria listed above.

Students who do not qualify for entry into the driver instruction sequence will be given written notice of the disqualification, and specifying how he/she may qualify.

Students transferring to a district continuation school may have their eligibility and placement postponed by the assistant principal of the high school of residence for a period not to exceed one year after the effective date of the transfer.

**Driver Training**

Fee Requirement: A fee of \$300 must be paid to the Adult Education Office prior to participation in driver training.
