Registration will be online only through the SPSH Tigers Webstore and the fee is \$22. Juniors have priority PSAT registration beginning on Thursday, September 5 through Friday September 20. Interested sophomores may register as of 8am, Monday, September 23 through Wednesday, October 9, 4pm, as space permits. Quantities are limited, all sales are final, and sales end on October 9, 4pm.

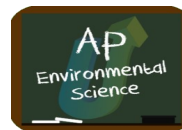

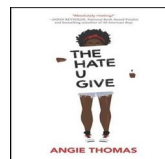
