Oxford Preparatory Academy Tuition Rate Sheet

- Annual Registration Fee of \$50 per child or \$100 for family (non-refundable) due upon enrollment and in Fall each year. Participants leaving the program for any length of time will be assessed the applicable Registration Fee upon return to the program.
- First month's tuition is due upon enrollment. 30-Day written notification required to cancel enrollment. Tuition will not be refunded or credited if proper written notification is not received 30-days in advance.
- Monthly Fee is automatically withdrawn from your bank or credit card on the 1st business day of the month
- There is a \$25 NSF fee imposed for each failed attempt to collect funds up to a maximum of \$50 (each month) Tuition not received by due date will incur a \$25 late payment fee and may lead to suspension of services
- All summer camp participants will be charged a Summer Activity Fee of \$100 on June 1st.
- A multi-child discount is available only to the responsible party, paying full tuition for two or more children
- The multi-child/family discount of 10% off applies to the oldest child(ren) only. Applicable to 3rd party agencies
- Part-time options (2 & 3 day plans) are subject to cancellation or limited enrollment. Modified days and full days for school closures are an additional charge if occurring on a non-registered day. Scheduled days must be specified at time of registration and must remain consistent
- Drop in daily rates are subject to availability. Before/After School on Regular School Day: \$40 per day per drop in, Full Day (6:30am-6:00pm): \$60 per day
- Prices are subject to change with a 30 day notice per the discretion of the YMCA
