Scabies

Date: _____

Symptoms: Caused by mite penetrating the skin, appearing as red, raised, linear rash, usually located between fingers, on wrists, elbows and waistline (skin folds). Itching is intense at night.

Incubation Period: Several days or weeks before itching is noticed.

How Transmitted: Direct contact with infected person or contact with soiled undergarments or bed clothes.

Treatment and Precautions: Contact your doctor or health department.

Return to School: After application of prescribed medicine and medical release to return to school.

Please call your child's school if your child will be absent due to above symptoms (or any other illness)
