

California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA)
Contractor's Pre-Qualification Application

Atwater Elementary School District would like to invite all interested parties who are licensed contractors to submit the name of their firm to Atwater Elementary School District (District) for inclusion on the District's 2018-19 list of qualified bidders for projects that are subject to our Board adopted California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA). This Act allows the District to informally bid small construction and maintenance projects with estimated costs not to exceed \$200,000.

THERE IS NO SUBMITTAL DEADLINE; NAMES WILL BE ADDED TO THE MAILING LIST AS THEY ARE RECEIVED.

You must resubmit to be included on the 2018/19 list even if your company has submitted an application in prior years.

Contractors that are interested in being on the 2018/19 Informal Bidding Contractors List are required to have a current license and are subject to verification through the Contractors State License Board.

Additionally, pursuant to SB 854, no contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and no contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the DIR per California Labor Code section 1725.5.
