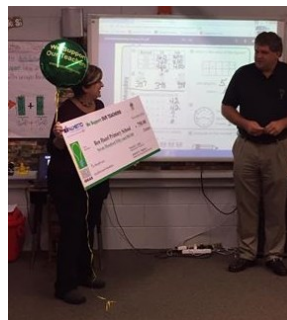


The Ascension Boys Club at Hampton Elementary recently participated in College Day at Claflin University. These young men are aspiring to not only graduate from high school, but to also further their education.
