


**Cafeteria - During both 1st & 2nd lunch for at least two days**

**Reminder on the 2nd day, that we will try this without sitting down first tomorrow as long as you show us your Ram Pride in the Cafeteria!**

**Lesson Objectives:** Students will be able to explain why the rules are important, give examples of what the rules look or sound like in the cafeteria, and demonstrate all cafeteria procedures.

**Lesson location:** Cafeteria

**Staff required:** Administration, Parapros, Lunch servers & cashiers, counselor

1. During 1st and 2nd lunch, direct students to sit at the lunch tables before getting in line for lunch (This will be in the morning announcements as well)
2. Each staff member needs to have Ram Bucks easily accessible to reward students
3. Display “Ram Attention” signal. Praise/thank/reward students who quickly make eye contact with the adult, imitate the signal, and become silent. Remind remaining students of this expectation. Practice, as necessary.

4. Explain the following expectations to all students quickly.
  - a. To demonstrate Ram Pride you quickly and quietly come into the cafeteria
  - b. When getting in line we maintain order by being patient
  - c. When getting lunch trays, take your time, be kind to others
  - d. When receiving food and paying for lunch, make sure to say hello, thank you, etc. to lunch staff  
(Without the lunch staff, you would be very hungry!)
  - e. When sitting with friends, be kind, look for others
  - f. Clean up your area

**5. Explain how you will dismiss students to go outside, library????**

6. Walk students through the procedures for entering the cafeteria, going through serving line, eating, cleaning up, and leaving (have students practice each step with their table with staff supervision, if students are having a difficult time, have them practice again)
